**A Reminder**

**School Safety and Security Reminders**

The safety of all pupils and staff are of utmost importance to us and we would like to remind of the following:

- Please take note of the opening times of gates and adhere to security screening if you are visiting the school or dropping your child off at the school gates.
- If you have an appointment with a teacher/staff, please enter **only** via Gate 2 to sign out a Visitor's Tag at the Guard House and ensure that the Visitor's Tag is displayed prominently while on the school grounds. Do proceed to the General Office to meet the teacher/staff and return the tag at the Guard House before you leave. If you are driving, please park at the HDB car park near to Gate 4.
- Do drive slowly if you are entering the school compound to drop off or pick up your child and adhere to the yellow boxes indicated on the ground for the area of drop off.
- Parents who wish to pick their child up before dismissal time must report to the General Office to sign their child out.
