Study and Well-being Tips

As the examination approaches, the following are some suggestions to help your child better prepare for the assessments.

1. Learning Environment is important:
 - Ensure there is a dedicated learning and study area which is away from other distractions.
 - Adequate lighting is available to ensure that the eyes are not strained over long periods of study.
2. Managing Time:
 - Write a list of what to study and to check off the list once it is completed. This will help your child to spread out their time for the required revision needed to excel.
 - Draw up a revision schedule and keep to it. Ensure that the schedule also have adequate rest time and exercise.
3. Focusing on the task:
 - Take short breaks after every 45 minutes of studying to exercise and rest the eyes.
 - Ensure the body keeps to a routine of rest and sleep.

Post Examination Activities

Edusave Merit Bursary	are within top 25% of each level academically, have good conduct and gross household income below \$6,900 per month (or per capita income of below \$1,725).	P1 to P3 - \$200 P4 to P6 - \$250	
Edusave Good Progress Award	are within the top 10% based on academic improvement and good conduct.	P2 to P3 - \$100 P4 to P6 - \$150
