Temperature-Taking Exercise

- Temperature-Taking Exercise will be conducted on 5 Jan 2018. Students are to bring their own oral digital thermometers on that day.
- Should your child need to purchase a thermometer, she can do so at the school bookshop. Each thermometer costs about \$4.50.
- All Primary 1 students will be given a thermometer in class, which will be kept by the Form Teacher. There is no need for Primary 1 students to make any purchase

School Safety & Security Reminders

The school places great emphasis on school safety and security. We seek parents' cooperation in the following ways:

- Please take note of the opening times of the gates and adhere to security screening if you are visiting the school or dropping your daughter off at the school gates.
- If you are planning to meet your daughter's teacher, please make an appointment by calling her beforehand or through email. As teachers have lessons, CCAs and programmes to see to, they may be unavailable if you come to the school without an appointment.
- If you have an appointment with a teacher/staff, please enter **only** via Gate 2 and sign in at the Guard House. Ensure that you put on the Visitor's Tag while on the school grounds. Please report to the General Office to meet the teacher/staff. Do return the tag at the Guard House before you leave. If you are driving, please park at the HDB car park near to Gate 4.

Please drive slowly if you are entering the school compound to drop off or pick up your daughter.

School dismissal will be done in a staggered manner. Please **do not** make changes to your daughter's dismissal arrangements, unless there is a medical/family emergency.

- Parents who wish to pick their daughter up before dismissal time must report to the General Office to sign their daughter out.
- Please **do not** wander around the school compound or go into the canteen for a meal or drink. Students are encouraged to bring only the necessary stationery items to school.
- **No** scissors, penknives or any sharp objects are to be brought to school.

Changes in Dental Clinic Schedule

From January 2018, the school will be having a new way of delivering dental treatment services. A Roving Dental Team will be arranged to provide dental services for students.

The school's dental clinic will be opened from 2 January to 31 March 2018.
