Reminders for Semestral Assessments 1 (SA1)

Students who are absent on any examination day (oral examination, composition examination, main paper etc) must produce a valid medical certificate stating the reason of the absence.

Parents are to call the general office to inform the school of the child's absence at the beginning of the day of the examination. There will be no make-up examinations for those who miss the paper.

Online Submission of Students' Travel Plans

All students are now required to submit their travel plans for the June school holidays online via AsknLearn. Parents are to login through your child's AsknLearn account to declare the details of the travel plan. This declaration will be available from Tuesday, 1 May 2018 to Friday, 11 May 2018.

Parents of all Primary 1 students need to declare the travel plans of your P1 child regardless of travel intent. Hence, **a NIL return is required.**

Environment Week

The school will celebrate Environment Week from 11 to 18 May 2018. During that week, there will be an assembly talk on the importance of recycling and the harmful effects of plastic to our environment.

Students will participate in Recycling competition where all classes are encouraged to bring their used plastic containers and bottles to school for that whole week to be deposited at the school's recycling bins. There will also be game booths set up during recess where our students can participate in game activities involving recycled materials.
